Samiti directs the office to obtain the said information from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and place it before Samiti for its consideration.

Item No. 3: To consider and decide on the letters /representations received.

- a) **Letters dated 12th October 2010 and 16th October 2010 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra and Ashvin Rural Ayurved College, Ahmednagar respectively requesting to permit the admissions of students on the Non-CET basis for Ayurved Course for Academic Year 2010-11.**

Samiti perused the Letters dated 12th October 2010 and 16th October 2010 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra and Ashvin Rural Ayurved College, Ahmednagar respectively requesting to permit the admissions of students on Non-CET basis for Ayurved course for Academic Year 2010-11.

After deliberation, Samiti permits to admit students for Ayurved (BAMS) course on the basis of MHT-CET-2010, ASSO-CET-2010 and thereafter, if any seats remain vacant, then on the basis of HSC score for the Academic Year 2010-11.

Samiti makes it clear that permission is granted only for Academic Year 2010-11 and this should not be treated as a precedent for years to come.

- b) **Letter dated 25th October 2010 received from Seth Govindji Raoji Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Solapur requesting to permit the admissions of Non-Minority candidates for Ayurved course for vacant seats for Academic Year 2010-11.**

Dr. A.S. Vyas, Officer on Special Duty, DMER, Mumbai and Member Expert Committee of Samiti pointed out that said college is Government aided institute.

After deliberations, Samiti in view of the institute being Government Aided College/Institute directs the aforesaid College/Institute to approach concerned authorities in Government.

Dr. Shraddha D. Sude, Asst. Director of Ayurved Deptt., M.S. and representative of Director, Ayurved, M.S. pointed out that number of students is too large and the number of seats available for State is too less for Post Graduate Ayurved course.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid college for Academic Year 2010-11 and onwards.



He stated that his son Dr. Devendra Prakash Kulkarni has secured admission in the management quota for MD Homoeopathy course at Foster Development Homoeopathic Medical College, Aurangabad for Academic Year 2010-11. He has paid the requisite fees of Rs. 65,000/- vide college receipt no. 16038 dated 12/07/2010. It was stated that the institute thereafter admitted five candidates and sent the final selection list of candidates admitted for MD Homoeopathy course for Academic Year 2010-11, where his name was not included. He therefore prayed for consideration of the list sent to Samiti's office on 10/11/2010. He further prayed not to consider and approve the earlier lists submitted by the said Institute.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to approve admissions of Dr. Devendra P. Samiti decides to approve admissions, subject to said candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria of APGH-CET-2010 and also norms/rules/regulations laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Samiti perused letter dated 9th November 2010 received from Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra regarding eligibility of MD (Hom) External candidates for Academic Year 2008-09.

Samiti heard Shri Prithviraj Patil, Secretary and Dr. Bagal, Competent Authority, Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra. It was stated that Dr. Nawaz Baid Wahed Beig has filled a Writ Petition - No. 9875 of 2008 in High Court, Bench at Aurangabad for the admission process of MD (Hom.) external course for the Academic Year 2008-09. It was further stated that Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik did not issue hall tickets of final exam to these candidates for the examinations held in Nov-2010. It is requested to approve the admissions done after the second round of APGH-CET-2008, as per the norms laid down by Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi for Academic Year 2008-09.

Samiti perused the order 27th November 2010 in High Court, Bench at Aurangabad in Writ Petition No. 6875 of 2008. Considering above, after deliberation, Samiti decides to approve the said admissions of MD (Hom.) external course for Academic Year 2008-09, subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria of APGH-CET-2008 and rules/Regulations/norms laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Dr. Ravi Bapat, Member of the Samiti pointed out that number of seats available for Post Graduate Homoeopathy course is too large, number of students opting for the course is too less. Samiti directs the Association to explain the circumstances leading to conduct CET for Post Graduate Homoeopathy Course. Samiti decides to seek an explanation from Associations as to why 'Common Admission Process' (CAP) satisfying the norms laid down by Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi for admission process of MD Homoeopathy Course, should not be followed. Association to submit the reply immediately to Samiti's office. After receipt of the said reply, it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

Proceedings were concluded with vote of thanks to the chair.
