Samiti noted the contents and appreciated the chart presented by the office. Samiti decides to call for the information from the respective associations, where they failed to supply the information to the office. (e.g. Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical & Dental Colleges, Mumbai should supply the information in column No. 16 to 17, Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical College of Maharashtra should supply the information in column No. 11 to 18, M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences, Pune should supply the information in column No. 15 to 18, M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy, Pune should supply the information in column No. 10 to 18 and Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions, Pune should supply the information in column No. 10 to 18.). Office should place the complete and updated information before Samiti.



Item No. 3: To consider and decide the Third Round of ASSO-CET-2010 conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges (AMUPMDC) of Maharashtra for Academic Year 2010-11.

Samiti perused the verified observation Report submitted by the Expert Committee appointed by the Samiti in respect of Third Round of Asso-CET-2010 conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai

The Expert Committee further checked, observed and verified the third Round of admission process.

For conduct of Third Round of admission process, Expert Committee further observed and verified the HSC PCB marks for MBBS and BDS course and found no discrepancy, since the marks are as per eligibility norms prescribed by the respective Councils and as per the data/ information furnished by the AMUPMDC in its ASSO-CET-2010.

In respect of the admissions of Reserved Category candidates, the Expert Committee further observed and found no discrepancy, since all allotted candidates are domiciled in Maharashtra State.

In view of the above, Samiti decides to approve, on the basis of the observations and verification report submitted by the Expert Committee, appointed by the Samiti the third round selection process conducted by AMUPMDC through ASSO-CET-2010 for Academic Year 2010-11.

Item No.4: To consider and decide on the following matter with the permission of the Chair.

(a) Letter dated 28th August 2010 received from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences, Pune requesting to conduct Second CET for BDS course for Academic Year 2010-11

Samiti perused the Letter dated 28th August 2010 received from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences, Pune requesting to conduct Second CET for BDS course for Academic Year 2010-11.

In view of the observation of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP (Civil) No. 306 of 2004 with Nos. 308, 345 of 2004, after deliberations Samiti decides that request made by M.A. Rangoonwala Dental College, Pune asking to conduct Second CET for BDS course for Academic Year 2010-11 can not to be approved at this stage. Samiti further directs the College/Institute to obtain the candidates from ASSO-CET-2010 and MHT-CET- 2010.

Samiti noted that per Item No. 2(b) number of students appeared in the College Entrance test and number of qualified students in the exam are shown as 154 and 106 respectively. Samiti directs the College/Institute to submit their explanation as to why they did not admit all these qualified students for its BDS course for Academic Year 2010-11.



(b) Letter dated 25th August 2010 received from DPO's NETT College of Physiotherapy, Thane regarding change of category of 02 students admitted for PT course for Academic Year 2009-10.

Samiti perused the letter dated 25th August 2010 received from DPO's NETT College of Physiotherapy, Thane regarding change of category of 02 students admitted for PT course for Academic Year 2009-10.

Samiti after deliberations directs the aforesaid College/Institute to submit the said letters refusing the Caste Validity to these candidates viz. - Miss Sneha Mukesh Chauhan and Miss Jagruti Ashok Patil to Samiti alongwith the explanation of the College as to whether any other candidate was denied the admission from the category to which the aforesaid candidates were admitted. The College is also directed to explain as to whether any injustice is caused or likely to be caused to any other candidate from any of the categories because of conversion to open category.

(C) Letter dated 18th August 2010 received from Sinhgad College of Nursing, Pune regarding change of category in respect of Rahul Nirmal Pawar admitted for B.Sc. Nursing Course for Academic Year 2009-10

Samiti perused the letter dated 18th August 2010 received from Sinhgad College of Nursing Pune regarding change of category in respect of Rahul Nirmal Pawar admitted for B.Sc. Nursing course for Academic Year 2009-10.

Samiti after deliberations directs the aforesaid College/Institute to submit the said letters refusing the Caste Validity to these candidate viz. - Rahul Nirmal Pawar to Samiti alongwith the explanation of the College as to whether any other candidate was denied the admission from the category to which the aforesaid candidates were admitted. The College is also directed to explain as to whether any injustice is caused or likely to be caused to any other candidate from any of the categories because of conversion to open category.

(d) Letters dated 26th August 2010 received from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik regarding approval / permission of Samiti for admission to 1st BHMS course and Post Graduate Homoeopathy course.

Samiti perused the Letters dated 26th August 2010 received from Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik about approval / permission of Samiti for admission to 1st BHMS course and Post Graduate Homoeopathy course.

After deliberations, Samiti reiterates that:-

- 1) Approval of Samiti is mandatory for all admissions done by the Competent Authority of the State Government.
 - 2) Approval of Samiti is mandatory for all admissions done at the respective Colleges by inviting applications.
 - 3) Approval of Samiti is mandatory for all NRI admissions done at the respective Colleges.

- 4) Approval of Samiti is mandatory for all admissions done by the Competent Authority of the AMHMCM.
- e) **To consider and decide on the Report of Expert Committee in respect of eligibility and approval of admission done in Academic Year 2009-10 and 2010-11.**

Such admissions will not be approved till the College/institutes submit compliance removing the discrepancy.
