



Samiti noted it. The colleges are directed to send in their proposals for the respective students for approval of PNS alongwith the relevant documents related to Non residential Indian students and of relationships of students with NRI relatives if any before 31/03/2011.



**Item No. 3: To discuss, consider and ratify the decisions taken on circulatory submission on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2011 and thereon letter dated 9/2/11 submitted by MUHS, Nashik.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 28/01/2011 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra requesting to permit Post Graduate Ayurvedic admission on the basis of Non - CET for the Academic Year 2010-11. The said letter was circulated amongst members of the Samiti for urgent decision- vide circulatory submission dated 28/01/2011; Samiti decides to approve admissions to MD/MS (Ayurved) A.Y. 2010-11, on Non – CET basis subject to the condition that the candidates fulfill the admission norms laid down by MUHS, Nashik & Central council of Indian Medicine (CCIM) New Delhi. Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges as under:-

- 1) Colleges are required to publish the advertised in the news paper.
- 2) The process be conducted in fair and transparent manner and on the basis of Merit.
- 3) The inter-se merit to be determined by the College/Institute.
- 4) All admissions to be done as per the norms/rules/guidelines/orders laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi and Medical Council of India, New Delhi.

**Item No.4: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

- a) **Letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2011 received from Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune alongwith the draft brochure of PGU-CET-2011 for Minority Management Quota admission to Post Graduate Unani Medical Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti considered the aforesaid Letter received from Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune along with the draft brochure of PGU-CET-2011 for Minority Management Quota admission to Post Graduate Unani Medical Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12.

After deliberations Samiti allows Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune to conduct CET for PGU-CET course for Academic year 2011-12. On the consideration to incorporate suggestion to be made by office of the Directorate of Ayurved, Maharashtra State.

- b) **Letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2011 received from Association of Muslim-Medical-Minority Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune alongwith draft brochure of UG(CET) - 2011 for minority management quota to first year Unani Medical Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2011 received from Association of Muslim-Medical-Minority Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune alongwith draft brochure of UG (CET)-2011 for minority management quota to first year Unani Medical Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12.

Considering the suggestion of Expert Committee on the draft brochure and after deliberations, Samiti allows Association of Muslim-Medical-Minority Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune to conduct CET for UG (CET) course for Academic Year 2011-12. Subject to the Following:-

- a) CET should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET should be conducted at the centers located in non Medical/Dental course Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non Medical faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of CET-2011 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Aforesaid College/Institute should ensure to that all allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. College/Institute should also ensure that college must have submitted Fee Approval proposal to the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2011-12. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are affiliated to universities for the academic year concerned. It should be ensured that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- g) Institute/Organization conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office. Vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The competent Authority will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges to without failed submit the following information to the Samiti office from time to time without fail-
  - i) No. of students appeared
  - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
  - iii) No. of participating Colleges with their sanction intake capacity.
  - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after rounds.
  - v) List of selected candidates of each round.



- vi) Details of complaints received during the process and details of action taken.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2011, as follows:-

- j) The Rule of eligibility, Tie breaker, etc. is at par with UG (CET)-2011 conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, (DMER) Mumbai
- k) **Rule No.15.1 - Refund of Fees:** The College is directed to follow the decisions taken by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (Medical Education) in its meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2007, in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the clause as follows:

*"As per the directions issued from the Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti it has been decided that if a seat is filled in and there is no vacant seats remain to be filled in by the College/Institute, in such a case, the College/Institute should deduct only up to Rs. 1,000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student should be refunded, otherwise the same would amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College /Institute should also return the original documents such as mark list, etc, collected from the students.*

*If a candidates expires or becomes invalid within three month from the date of admission, full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges."*

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes/conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of UG (CET)-2011 of Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, for Minority Management Quota admissions for its Post Graduate course for Academic Year 2011-12.

- C) Letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011 received from Association of Management of Ayurved Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai alongwith draft brochure of APGA-CET-2011 for Post Graduate Ayurved admissions for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the aforesaid letter received from Association of Management of Ayurved Medical Colleges of Maharashtra – requesting to grant permission for conducting CET for Post Graduate in Ayurved course for Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti perused the letters dated 10<sup>th</sup> December 2010 and 28<sup>th</sup> January 2011 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra. They have requested to grant the admission to non CET students on the basis of percentage criteria where seats fall vacant even after publication of advertisement in the newspaper.

After deliberations, Samiti decides not to accede to the request of the Association of Management of Ayurved Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai to conduct APGA-CET-2011 for Post Graduate Ayurved admissions for Academic Year 2011-12.

- d) **Letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011 received from Association of Management of Private and Unaided Medical and Dental College, Maharashtra (AMUPMDC) alongwith the draft brochure of ASSO-CET-2011 for first year Health Sciences admissions for Academic Year 2011-12 and observation/verification report submitted by Expert Committee, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai vide its letter dated 21/02/2011.**

Samiti perused the Letter dated 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011 received from Association of Management of Private and Unaided Medical and Dental College, Maharashtra (AMUPMDC) alongwith the draft brochure of ASSO-CET-2011 for first year Health Sciences admissions for Academic Year 2011-12. Samiti also perused observation/verification report submitted by Expert Committee, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai vide its letter dated 21/02/2011.

After deliberations, Samiti allows Association of Management of Private and Unaided Medical and Dental College, Maharashtra (AMUPMDC) to conduct CET for first year Health Sciences course for Academic Year 2011-12, subject to the following terms and conditions--

- a) CET should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET should be conducted at the centers located in non Medical/Dental course Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non Medical faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of CET-2011 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Aforesaid College/Institute should ensure to that all allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. College/Institute should also ensure that college must have submitted Fee Approval proposal to the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2011-12. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are affiliated to universities for the academic year concerned. It should be ensured that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- g) Institute/Organization conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office. Vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.



- h) The competent Authority will be Grievance Redressal Authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges to without fail submit the following information to the Samiti office from time to time without fail-
- i) No. of students appeared
  - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
  - iii) No. of participating Colleges with their sanction intake capacity.
  - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after round.
  - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
  - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and thereon what action to be taken.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2011, as follows:-

- j) The Rule of eligibility, Tie breaker, etc. is at par with first year Health Sciences conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, (DMER) Mumbai
- k) Rule No.15.1 - Refund of Fees: The College is directed to follow the decisions taken by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (Medical Education) in its meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2007, in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the clause as follows:

*"As per the directions issued from the Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti it has been decided that if a seat is filled in and there is no vacant seats remain to be filled in by the College/Institute, in such a case, the College/Institute should deduct only up to Rs. 1,000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student should be refunded, otherwise the same would amount to profiteering and charging of capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College /Institute should also return the original documents such as mark list, etc, collected from the students.*

*If a candidates expires or becomes invalid within three month from the date of admission, full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges."*

Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges/Institutes to follow Final Revised Scheme for 'Common Admission Process' approved by Hon'ble High Court in review Writ Petition No. 120 of 2006 in Writ Petition No 6332 under of 2005 (copy enclosed – **ANNEXURE - A**).

In the case of any cancellation of admission in all Health Science Courses, the decision of the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (Medical Education) shall be applicable, final and binding on AMUPMDC/Colleges/Institutes.

Samiti perused letter received from Maharashtra Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Latur regarding Seats sharing of Post Graduate MD/MS courses admission for the academic year 2011-12 onwards.

Samiti also perused Letter dated 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 received from Vasantdada Patil Dental College and Hospital regarding allotment of 50% MDS Seats under the Mangement Quota in MDS Post Graduate Dental Courses for the Academic year 2011-12. Samiti further perused Letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> February received from Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra regarding Seats Sharing.

Samiti after deliberation permits the seats sharing formula of post graduate MD/MS courses admission for the academic year 2011-12 as under:-

"CET is mandatory for admissions. Samiti directs the aforesaid colleges to prepare the merit list on the basis of average of marks of three CET's i.e. Govt. CET, ASSO-CET, and National CET. First preference should be given to Government CET candidates, second preference should be given to the National CET candidates and thereafter third preference should be given to the ASSO-CET candidates.

Samiti further directs the aforesaid College/Institutes to fill up the 50% seats from CAP and remaining 50% (including 15% NRI Quota) seats on the basis of following:-

- 1) College/Institute may admit candidate under that 50% management quota from the candidates appearing and passing CET examination of Government CET, ASSO-CET and recognized National CET.
- 2) The inter-se merit to be determined by the College/Institute.
- 3) All admission to be done as per the norms/rules/guidelines/orders laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi and Medical Council of India, New Delhi."



- f) **Letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2010 received from Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik in respect of the decision taken in the Samiti in its meeting held on 25/9/2010 [(at Item No. 3(b)) about the admissions of 1) Sneha M.Chavan and 2) Jagruti M. Patil admitted in B.P.Th. course for Academic Year 2009-10.**

Samiti perused the Letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2010 received from Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik in respect of the decision taken in the Samiti in its meeting held on 25/9/2010 [(at Item No. 3(b)) about the admissions of 1) Sneha M.Chavan and 2) Jagruti M. Patil admitted in B.P.Th. course for Academic Year 2009-10.

Samiti after deliberation decides, not to approve the admissions of those candidates for B.P.Th. course for Academic year 2009-10. Admissions viz.- Miss. Sneha Mukesh Chavan and Miss. Jagruti Ashok Patil stand disapproval.

Samiti observes that Mr. Rahul Swarnchand Bangar had submitted the application under SC category and he was unable to produce Cast Validity Certificate. He produced the letter of Caste Validity and Scrutiny Committee mentioning their in that his file was under process.

After deliberations, Samiti decides not to approve the admission of Mr. Rahul Swarnchand Bangar for FY BDS course for Academic Year 2010-11 at Maharashtra Institute of Dental Sciences and Research, Latur in view of the fact that he secured admission under SC category but failed to substantiate his social status claim accordingly.

In view of the above after deliberation, Samiti decides not to approval the request made by the aforesaid College/Institute.
