



In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti decides no further extension for submission of admission details. Samiti also decides that admission process of the aforesaid Colleges/Institutes will not be regularised for the Academic Year 2011-12.

**Item No. 3: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

- a) **Letters dated 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2011 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical College of Maharashtra, Mumbai and Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai regarding verification of admission process respectively.**

Samiti perused the letters under references.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that all private professional and unaided Health Sciences Colleges/Institutes in the State of Maharashtra is mandatory to submit their admission details to Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti.

Samiti directs all Private Unaided Ayurved, Homoeopathy, Unani, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, B.Sc. Nursing, Post Graduate Ayurved and Post Graduate Homoeopathy Colleges to submit their admission details to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for verification from Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti also directs Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik to verify the admission details and admission process of Ayurved, Homoeopathy, Unani, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, B.Sc. Nursing, Post Graduate Ayurved and Post Graduate Homoeopathy Colleges and submit their verification/observations report before the Samiti for its consideration and final approval. After receipt of the same it be placed before Samiti for its consideration.

- b) **Letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> September 2011 received from Sonajirao Kshrisagar Homoeopathic Medical College, Beed asking to permit admissions of 02 M.D. Homoeopathic candidates on the basis of norms laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathic, New Delhi for the Academic Year 2010-11.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides not to consider fresh changes at this stage, in view of the fact that the cut off date is already over.

- c) **Letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011 received from Siddhakala Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Ahmednagar asking to include their college in the list of admission process for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference. Samiti also perused the Hon'ble High Court order in Writ Petition No. 7597 of 2011 dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti permit to do provisional admissions for its B.A.M.S. and Post Graduate Ayurved course for the Academic Year 2011-12, subject to the conditions laid down by the Hon'ble High Court order in Writ Petition No. 7597 of 2011.

- d) **Letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2011 received from Vengurla Homoeopathic Medical College, Vengurla asking to permit change of category in respect of Kum. Prachi Vitthal Singnath admitted in first year B.H.M.S. course for Academic Year 2010-11.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

It is observed that there are number of applications from the candidates forwarded by the respective Colleges/Institutes where the candidates have taken admission for change from constitutional reserved category to open category. This is due to the fact that the candidates do not get his/her Caste Validity Certificate and/or Non-Creamy Layer certificate.

After deliberation, Samiti decides to permit to change of reservation category quota to open category quota as :-

- (i) There should be vacancy in the open category in the respective College/Institute in the same year merit list.
- (ii) The change of category shall be permitted within the academic year of admission i.e. upto 31<sup>st</sup> July of the respective academic year.
- (iii) The candidate should fulfill the eligibility criteria of the open category as laid down by their respective council and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

It is observed that College / Institute vide its aforesaid letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> September 2011 has mention that there is 11 seats vacant in open category for its B.H.M.S. course for the Academic Year 2010-11, In view of the above after deliberation Samiti decides to permit the admission of Kum. Prachi Vitthal Singhnath in open category for first year B.H.M.S. course for the Academic Year 2010-11.

**Item No. 4: To consider and decide on the Verification Report on the status of NRI candidates admitted during Academic Year 2009-10 and 2011-12 on the basis of documents/relevant papers submitted by the Colleges/Institutes.**

Samiti perused the Verification Report submitted by office on the status of the NRI candidates who were admitted in Post Graduate MD/MS, First Year MBBS and BDS course in academic year 2009-10 and 2011-12 respectively. **(a) Letter dated 4<sup>th</sup> October 2011 received from Kum. Pratima Prakash Dhanbhar complaining against Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College, Amravati regarding admission process**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti already heard to Kum. Pratima Prakash Dhanbhar in its previous meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2011 (at Item No. 7[d]), accordingly the claim of the candidate for admission is earlier rejected by the Samiti.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti decides that decision taken by Samiti in the previous meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2011 warrants no change. All decisions of the Committee those were taken herein before in respect of admission of Kum. Pratima Prakash Dhanbhar stands as they are without any alterations, modifications, etc.

- (b) **Letter dated 29th August 2011 received from Dilip B. Ingole requesting for enquiry into malpractices adopted during admission process at Dr. P.D. Medical College, Amravati.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti directs the College/Institute for Against NRI Quota admissions should publish the vacancy position in Local Newspapers as well as State Level Newspapers. The College/Institute also to display vacancy position on their website and the Notice Board .

- (c) **Letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011 received from Rahul I. Desai complaining against selection process of ASSO-PGA-CET-2011.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Dr. M.P. Bankar, Officer on Special Duty, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai is pointed out as per the Annexure – G of Asso-PGA-CET-2011 brochure if the candidates field the Status Retention Form, then he will not be eligible for next subsequent rounds of selection process for the Academic Year 2011-12.

In view of the above, after deliberation, Samiti decides that claim of the Rahul I. Desai for admission is rejected.

Bankar, Officer of Special Duty, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai has pointed out that their are a large number of students are waiting for B.A.M.S. admissions in MHT-CET-2011, figure of MHT-CET-2011 candidates for B.A.M.S. course is too large and figure of seats available for admission is too less.

In view of the above, after deliberations, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid Association and college to permit admission of B.A.M.S. course on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2011-12.

It is observed that the candidates are not fulfilled the requisite marks in APGH-CET-2011, therefore, Samiti decides not to accede to the request made by the aforesaid College/Institute.

- (j) **Letters dated 17<sup>th</sup> October 2011 and 18<sup>th</sup> October 2011 received from Kasturba Health Society, Wardha and Sinhgad College of Nursing, Pune requesting to permit M.Sc. Nursing admissions on the basis of Non-CET for Academic Year 2011-12 respectively.**

Samiti also perused the letter No. एनयुआर/सिंहगड/एम.एस्सी.(न)/प्रवेश/२०११-१२/३/ई/११, dated 20/09/2011.

Dr. M.P. Bankar and Dr. P.R. Raikar, Officer of Special Duty, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai has pointed out that Government of Maharashtra has not conducted CET for M.Sc. Nursing course for the Academic Year 2011-12.

In view of the above, after deliberation Samiti decides to approve the admissions of M.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2011-12 with requisite eligible marks laid down by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, subject to permission/affiliation of all Central Government, Indian Nursing Council, Government of Maharashtra, Maharashtra Nursing Council, Mumbai and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for the Academic Year 2011-12.
