No discrepancy found in 85% quota 3 candidates are selected against NRI quota. No discrepancy found. 4 candidates are selected in NRI quota. PNS may verify the NRI status of these candidates.
2	NKP Salve MC, Nagpur Intake:150	College has submitted following details. 1. Vacancy position after 3rd round. 2. List of applications against vacant seats & increased seats. 3. List of applications against NRI quota. 128 Candidates are selected in 85% quota for academic year 2010-11 in 85% quota. 51 candidates are selected against vacant seats and increased seats. No discrepancy found in 85% quota. 15 candidates are selected against NRI quota. No discrepancy found. 7 candidates are selected in NRI quota. PNS may verify the NRI status of these candidates.

No discrepancy found in 85% Quota. 10 candidates are selected against NRI quota. No discrepancy found. 5 candidates are selected in NRI quota. PNS may verify the NRI status of these candidates.

1.	*ZVM Unani College, Pune Intake: 15 Vacant: 0	<p>15 Candidates are selected for academic year 2010-11.</p> <p>College has provided Final Merit List & APGU-CET 10 Mark-sheets of selected candidates. However merit data (CETNO, Marks & Rank) of candidates does not match with mark-sheet data. E.g. Mark-sheet of roll No. A-029 mentions merit number 9 and marks 166, but in the merit list, same roll number is shown with same marks but merit number 23.</p> <p>It is also observed that merit numbers of first eight candidates are in accordance with the total marks obtained, but from merit number 9 onwards the order of marks is different from the sequence of merit numbers.</p> <p>Hence it is not possible to verify the correctness of the selection list.</p>

1.	Sinhgad Institute of Nursing Education, Pune Intake:25	<p>College was stated previously that 4 candidates were selected in NRI quota. Now college has explained that instead of 4 candidates, only one candidate was selected in NRI quota and remaining 3 candidates (Sneha Ghule, Prameet Waghmare & Snehal Borse) were selected against NRI quota and they have secured requisite marks in APGN-CET 2010. No discrepancy found in those admissions.</p> <p>24 candidates are selected in 85% quota. No discrepancy found.</p> <p>One candidate is selected in NRI quota. PNS may verify the NRI status of this candidate.</p>
