

Samiti directs the office to obtain the willingness of eminent personalities and put up the proposal accordingly before Samiti for its consideration.


Item No.4: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-

- a) **Letter dated 10th February 2011 received from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research, Pune alongwith draft brochure of CET - 2011 for minority management quota to Post Graduate course in Physiotherapy Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12 and observation/verification report submitted by Expert Committee, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai vide its letter dated 23/03/2011.**

Samiti perused the Letter dated 10th February 2011 received from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research, Pune alongwith draft brochure of CET - 2011 for minority management quota to Post Graduate course in Physiotherapy Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12 and observation/verification report submitted by Expert Committee, Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai vide its letter dated 23/03/2011.

After deliberations Samiti allows M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research, Pune to conduct CET for Post Graduate course in Physiotherapy for Academic year 2011-12, and directs as under -

- a) CET should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET examinations should be conducted at the centers located in non related faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non related faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi.



- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of CET-2011 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.
- f) Aforesaid College/Institute should ensure to that all allotment of students to colleges is made strictly as per merit and as per the options of choices exercised. College/Institute should also ensure that college must have submitted Fee Approval proposal to the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2011-12. It should also to be ensured that allotment of students is done only to the colleges who are affiliated to universities for the academic year concerned. It should be ensured that colleges submit the list of admissions within two days form the cut off date to Samiti's office.
- g) Institute/Organization conducting CET/ CAP should communicate to Samiti's office. The vacancy details immediately after the last round is over but within 7 days.
- h) The competent Authority will be grievance redressal authority who will take care of all complaints of students/parents during CET examinations and admission process. Association/ College should further ensure appointment of appellate authority to hear and decide and dispose of grievances against the decisions of said competent authority.
- i) Samiti further directs the Association/Colleges to without failed submit the following information to the Samiti office in time to time.
- i) No. of students appeared
 - ii) No. of students qualified in the Exam.
 - iii) No. of participating Colleges with their sanction intake capacity.
 - iv) Course/Subject/category wise seat matrix of each round, before and after round.
 - v) List of selected candidates of each round.
 - vi) Details of complaints received during the process and thereon what action to be taken.

Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2011, as follows:-

- j) The Rule of eligibility, Tie breaker, etc. is at par with M.P.Th.-CET-2011 conducted by Directorate of Medical Education and Research, (DMER) Mumbai
- k) Rule - Refund of Fees: The College is directed to follow the decisions taken by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (Medical Education) in its meeting held on 6th June 2007, in the matter of refund of fees and incorporate the clause as follows:

"As per the directions issued from the Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti it has been decided that if a seat is filled in and there is no vacant seats remain to be filled in by the College/Institute, in such a case, the College/Institute should deduct only up to Rs. 1,000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student should be refunded, otherwise the same would amount to profiteering and charging of

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capitation fees. The Samiti further directs that the College /Institute should also return the original documents such as mark list, etc, collected from the students.

If a candidates expires or becomes invalid within three month from the date of admission, full refund shall be made after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as administrative charges."

Samiti, subject to the incorporation of the aforesaid changes/conditions, grants its approval to the draft brochure of CET-2011 of M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research, Pune for Minority Management Quota admissions to Post Graduate course in Physiotherapy for Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti perused the Letter dated 28th February 2011 received from Association of Managements of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai requesting to permit to start MD (Hom.) Regular Course APGH-CET-2011 for Post Graduate Homoeopathic course for Academic Year 2011-12 alongwith draft brochure and observation/verification report submitted by Expert Committee, Directorate of Ayurved, M.S., Mumbai vide its letter dated 30/03/2011.

After deliberations Samiti allows Association of Managements of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai to conduct CET for Post Graduate Homoeopathic course for Academic year 2011-12, and directs as under -

- a) CET should be conducted in fair and transparent manner and admission process to be on the basis of Merit.
- b) CET examinations should be conducted at the centers located in non related faculty Colleges and staff of examination i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator, Center In-charge and other staff should be drawn from non related faculty.
- c) List of notified centers with details of seating arrangement made in each such centers and list of eligible candidates appearing for examination to be provided to Samiti. No. of seats available college wise to be provided to Samiti.
- d) Schedule of CET should be as per directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi & control council of Homoeopathic, New Delhi.
- e) Result of CET should be displayed on website and the notice boards. Result of APGH -CET-2011 to be submitted to the Samiti office, within two days from the date of declaration of result.

College/Institute should also ensure that college must have submitted Fee Approval proposal to the Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Maharashtra State for finalization of fees structure the Academic Year 2011-12. Samiti further directs, to incorporate the following changes in final Rules and Information Brochure of CET-2011, as follows:-

1. As Front page of Brochure, It should be mentioned as 'Asso-PGH-CET -2011.' 'Asso-PGH-CET -2011.' should be mentioned everywhere in place of 'APGH- CET-2011'
2. Important Dates – Application of verification of marks up to 6/7/2011 for more clerity.
3. Note (Page No. 5) – Competent Authority admits students only after verification of all documents.
4. New Item – Rule No. 7.7—Competent Authority shall display the Answer key of all versions of question papers within two hours of completion of examination on their Website for more transperancy in the examination.
5. Rule No. 8.5 (Page No. 7) – Duplicate marksheet prescribed fees of Rs. 200/- . Rs 1000/- for duplicate marksheet is not reasonable.
6. Rule No. 8.6 (Page No. 7) – Competent Authority will give the zerox copy of Answersheet & answer key of his/her version for the transperancy of the system.



Samiti perused the aforesaid Letter dated 10th February 2011 received from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research, Pune alongwith draft brochure of CET-2011 for minority management quota to first year Physiotherapy Colleges in Maharashtra for Academic Year 2011-12 for approval of Samiti.

After going through, Samiti decides that the copy of draft brochure for conduct of CET-2011 submitted by the aforesaid College/Institute would be sent to the Expert Committee i.e. Office of Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State for their scrutiny and comments/ remarks. After receipt of said comments/ remarks from the Office of the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Mumbai, the College/Institute would be conveyed the necessary changes/modifications to be carried out in the said draft brochure



and thereafter the final approval to the brochure would be given by the Samiti to the College/Institute.

After deliberations, Samiti decides to permit disposal of the material only from the year 2006 to 2008. Samiti also decides that the association should ensure to retain the matters documents related to court cases, if any.

2. New Item After Rule No. 3.8 (Page No. 12) : Competent Authority shall display the Answer Key of all versions of Question Papers within two hours of completion of examination on their website.
3. Rule No. 6.9 : Rule No. 6.9 to be deleted to avoid duplicasy as it is already mentioned at Rule No. 6.10.
4. Rule No. 7 : Caste Certificate Caste Validity and Non-creamy Layer Certificate should be mentioned before Sub-Rule No. 7.2, , it is mandatory to submit Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate from the candidates admitted in reserved category quota
5. Rule No. 8 : The Competent Authority will conduct the examination, evaluate the answer sheets and prepare Merit List for students, separate Quota for Teachers, Medical Personnel and Out of State candidates is not shown in Brochure, hence it is deleted.
6. ANNEXURE – L : The Constitutional Reservations (BC) should be added. This annexure is essential to fill up the seats of 50% Government Quota.

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7. Reund of fees: The College is directed to follow the decisions taken by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (Medical Education) in its meeting held on 6th June 2007, in the matter of refund of fees and incorporates the clause as follows:
