After deliberation Samiti to accede to the request of the Association to admit the students on the basis of MHT-CET-2011, ASSO-CET-2011 and if there are any vacancy then only on the basis of 12th Science passed students with requisite eligible marks as laid down by the Central Council of Homoeopathic, New Delhi & Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik subject to permission/affiliation of Central Government of India, Central Council of Homoeopathic, (CCH) New Delhi, Government of Maharashtra and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for Academic Year 2011-12.

- (l) **Letter dated 22nd September 2011 received from Association of Management of Unaided Nursing Colleges (Maharashtra) requesting to permit admissions of B.Sc. Nursing and M.Sc. Nursing on the basis of Non-CET for the Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation Samiti decides to approve the request made by the aforesaid

College/Institute to admit the students on the basis of MHT-CET-2011, ASSO-CET-2011 and thereafter if there are vacancies then only on the basis of 12th science std. passed students with requisite eligible marks laid down by their respective Councils, subject to permission/affiliation of all Central Government, Indian Nursing Council, Government of Maharashtra, Maharashtra Nursing Council, and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Samiti further directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2011-12 and the Colleges/Institutes should not treat it as a precedent for the years to come.

- (m) **Letter dated 19th September 2011 received from Sinhgad Dental College, Pune in respect of the decision taken by the Samiti in its meeting held on 19th July 2011 (at Item No. 5[a]) regarding admission of Ms. Rupali Pradeep Bharambe admitted for BDS Course in Academic Year 2010-11.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

After deliberation, Samiti decides that the fresh changes at this stage cannot be considered, since the cut-off-date is already over. Request rejected.

- (n) **Letter dated 26th September 2011 received from Sumit S. Goje requesting for the admission for MBBS course for Academic Year 2011-12 through vacant seats as per allotted by AMUPMDC.**

Samiti perused the letter under reference.

Samiti heard Dr. N.S. Arvikar, Dean, Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College.

Samiti heard the candidate. He stated that NDMVP Nashik College and Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College, Jalgaon were approached on 19th /20th /21th September 2011 by him for admissions. He was refused inspite of his merit.

Samiti observes that the complainant did not follow the procedure laid down for admissions against vacant seats after CAP rounds.

In view of the above after deliberation, Samiti decides to reject the application of Sumit S. Goje.

- o) **To consider and decide on the Verification Report submitted by the Expert Committee, i.e. Directorate of Ayurved, Mumbai on the status of candidates admitted during 2009-10 and 2010-11.**

Samiti perused the verification & observation report submitted by Expert Committee – Directorate of Ayurved Maharashtra State, Mumbai in respect of First Year Health Science courses admissions for Academic Year 2009-10 and 2010-11.

After deliberation Samiti decides to approve the admissions where there are no discrepancies. Where there are discrepancies, such proposals to be kept before Samiti after removal of the discrepancies, the details are as under –

M. J.
