**Item No. 3: To conduct the verification process for second round of ASSO-CET-2011 conducted by Association of Management of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Maharashtra as per the schedule of Hon'ble High Court order in Review Petition No. 120 of 2006 and Writ Petition No. 7799 of 2010.**

Samiti expresses its displeasure to Association for not having considered the second round. Samiti directs the Association to allot candidates only to those colleges who have requisite permissions/ affiliations/continuations of the respective council, Central Government of India, Government of Maharashtra and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik for Academic Year 2011-12.

**Item No.4: To consider and decide on the letters/representations received:-**

- a) **Letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Vidarbha Medical Education & Research Foundation Jamanlal Goenka Dental College & Hospital, Akola asking for admissions to 1<sup>st</sup> year BDS course for Academic Year 2011-12 in view of orders of Hon'ble High Court.**

Samiti perused Letter under reference.

Dr. Arun Jamkar, member pointed out that Central government having refused the permission. Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik has not given the affiliation/continuation.

In absence of affiliation from the university and in absence of permission from Central Government, request of the college can not be approved.

**Item No.5: To consider and decide on following complaints received from Students/Parents in respect of the admission process of Health Science courses for the Academic Year 2011-12.**

- a) **Letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Ankit Shyambahadur Singh applying for correction of selection list of MBBS course for Academic Year 2011-12.**  
and  
b) **Letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Anupama Ashok Kashid asking for his selection in CAP 1<sup>st</sup> round through ASSO-CET- 2011 conducted by AMUPMDC.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Ankit Shyambahadur Singh applying for correction of selection list of MBBS course for Academic Year 2011-12.

Samiti heard Ankit Shyambahadur Singh and Anupama Kashid, the Applicants and Smt. Ranga Srivvasan, Administrative officer of Association of Management of Unaided Private & Dental colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai.

Smt. Ranga administrative officer of association stated that applications of said candidates were being considered in Second Round of ASSO-CET-2011.

After deliberation Samiti directs the Association to consider the preferences of the Ankit Shyambahadur Singh and Anupama Kashid as per their preference & merit. Samiti also directs the Association not to repeat same mistake in future.

- c) **Letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Dr. Vilas K. Kharche, Akola complaining against Dr. P.D. Medical College, Amravati citing an advertisement in daily Loksatta, Nagpur dated 11/7/2011 regarding NRI quota admissions and Scedule of admission process.**

Samiti perused the letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Dr. Vilas K. Kharche, Akola complaining against Dr. P.D. Medical College, Amravati citing an advertisement in daily Loksatta, Nagpur dated 11/7/2011 regarding NRI quota admissions and Scedule of admission process.

Dr.Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati vide its letter dated 8/8/2011, stated that Kaustubh Kharche, if is eligible for the admission in NRI quota and stands in merit he will be preferred and his name will be included in the selection list. If his claim turns out to be genuine he will be admitted for 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS for the Academic Year 2011-12.

After deliberation Samiti decides, to forward reply submitted by Dr.Panjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Medical College, Amravati to complaintant Dr. Vilas K. Kharche for his comments.

- d) **Email dated 25<sup>th</sup> July 2011 received from Raju Pawar complaining about malpractices in N.D.M.V.P.S Medica College, Nashik for seeking admission in MBBS course for Academic Year 2011-12.**

Samiti perused the email under reference.

Aforesaid College/Institute vide its letter dated 26/7/2011 has granted the admission to complaint. Samiti noted the same.

- e) **Letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2011 received from Ansari Mohammed Abdullah Tauheed Ahmed complaining against AMMMEI-PGU-CET-2011 conducted by Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune and requesting restoration of transparency in selection procedure of PG Unani Courses and there up on reply submitted by Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune vide its letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2011.**

Samiti perused letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2011 received from Ansari Mohammed Abdullah Tauheed Ahmed complaining against AMMMEI-PGU-CET-2011 conducted by Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune and requesting restoration of transparency in selection procedure of PG Unani Courses and there up on reply submitted by Association of Muslim Minorities Medical Educational Institutions of Maharashtra, Pune vide its letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2011.

Association submitted their reply vide Letter No. MVPS Dr. VPMCH & RC/1/88/2011-12 dated 26/7/2011.

After deliberation Samiti decides to forward the reply to the complainant.

Samiti heard Dr. Sudhir Patil, Vice-President and Dilip Ingole, Chairman.

In view of the fact that the college is not affiliated to university the admission to the colleges in absence of affiliation of university cannot be approve.

Samiti further directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2011-12 and the Association and Colleges/Institutes should not treat it as a precedent for the years to come.


